- You are urged to raise your trip from support partners and your church. Your report to your partners will multiply the movement!
- Trip cost is approximately \$2,100 USD if booked by December 31, 2013. Cost includes your lodging, most meals, train fare, cab fares, the conference, consultation briefing and debriefing by the Church Doctor® Team.
- Taking it home: you will write a personal Action Plan, reflecting how God leads you and your church following this “Book of Acts Experience.”
- You are responsible to book your own flight arrangements from your gateway city in North America to Manchester, England.
- After arriving in Manchester, we will have teaching sessions and visit at least two pioneering ministries in Manchester. Then we will travel by train to experience the Sheffield church.
- Some seminaries, Bible colleges, and universities may allow credit for advanced degrees by way of independent study for the England Mission Immersion Experience.

God Watchers

In the classic book *Experiencing God*, Henry Blackaby describes two different ways of planning: 1) think up an idea and pray like crazy for God to bless it; or, 2) look where God is already blessing and join Him there. This is an essential, biblical principle for ministry. Jesus taught in John 5:19, “*I’m telling you this straight. The Son can’t independently do a thing, only what he sees the Father doing. What the Father does, the Son does*” (*The Message*).

This is our approach at Church Doctor Ministries. We are “God watchers,” and for almost 40 years, we have made journeys all over the world where God is blessing the church. For the last 12 years, Church Doctor Ministries has taken church leaders from North America to England so they can see, feel, and become infected by the Spirit with the DNA of mission and revival! 
St. Thomas Crookes, Sheffield
